Annual Report of Army Public School, The MARATHA LIRC, Belagavi for the year 2024–25 — a year marked by progress, purpose, and promise. This annual report comprises the achievements and excellence made during the year gone by and at the same time sets the path for greater accomplishments in the years to come. Keeping the legacy alive we have always stepped forward and come up with distinctive plans for the holistic development of our students. I whole-heartedly take you through the glimpses of all our expeditions and excitements as we march towards a journey of innovations and progress.

Our school continues to nurture this progressive thinking — where learning is student-centric, teachers act as facilitators, and every child finds a voice, a dream, and a direction.

With humble beginnings as Jija Mata Pre Primary school, our school has come a long way to stand where it is today. Last year, our school took a historic step by coming under the umbrella of **HQ AWES, New Delhi**, and affiliating with **CBSE, Delhi** from **1st April 2024**. We now function from 11 permanent blocks with well-equipped laboratories, a modern computer-cum-language lab, a rich library, and upgraded sports facilities.

Academic Progress

The academic year 2024–25 was our **first session under CBSE affiliation**, effective **1 April 2024**, under the aegis of **HQ AWES, New Delhi**.

- The school now functions from **11 permanent blocks** with 43 classrooms, well-equipped **science and mathematics laboratories**, a **computer-cum-language lab**, and a **well-stocked library**.
- The **academic framework** has been realigned with the **CBSE pattern** and **NEP 2020 guidelines**, emphasizing conceptual clarity, critical thinking, and experiential learning.
- **Teachers act as facilitators**, ensuring active participation through discussions, projects, and peer collaboration.
- Regular **formative assessments**, **enrichment activities**, and **remedial classes** after school hours have supported learners at every level.

A milestone achievement this year is that **73 students** will appear for the **school's first CBSE Class X Board Examination** in the upcoming session 2025–26. Their performance is being strengthened through mock tests, mentoring, and continuous feedback.

Class X Result (2024–25)

The **first internal CBSE-aligned result** reflected commendable performance across all subjects, with several students scoring above 90% in core subjects. Subject toppers and all-rounders were felicitated to celebrate academic excellence and perseverance.

Student-Centric Pedagogy

Our teaching approach revolves around the belief that *every learner is unique*.

- Classroom teaching integrates **activity-based methods, project learning, and digital tools** through newly installed smart panels.
- The “**Bagless Day**” initiative every third Saturday encourages experiential learning through art, music, community work, and life-skills sessions.
- A **Resource Room** has been set up as a **study hub** where students can read, collaborate, and seek academic guidance.

This child-centered pedagogy has made classrooms more engaging and joyful, transforming teachers into **facilitators of learning** rather than transmitters of content.

Co-Curricular and Enrichment Activities

Co-curricular activities continue to be an integral part of holistic education at APS Belagavi.

- Regular **inter-house competitions** in debate, recitation, quiz, art, and music helped students build confidence and creativity.
- **Hobby Clubs** — including Eco Club, IT Club, Heritage Club, and Robotics Club — allowed learners to explore their passions.
- Special events such as **Investiture Ceremony, Independence Day, Swachhatta Diwas**, Vigilance Week and **Literary Week** were celebrated with enthusiasm and purpose.
- Students also participated in the **Vidyanjali Project** and **ECHS SPARSH activities**, promoting civic awareness and social responsibility.

Sports Achievements

Sports form the backbone of discipline and teamwork in our institution.

- Students excelled in **inter-school, zonal, and cluster-level competitions** in Judo, boxing, swimming, skating etc..
- The **NCC Troop No. 168/26**, raised on **19 September 2025** under **26 Kar Battalion NCC**, enrolled **50 cadets** under 100% Central funding — a proud step toward leadership and national service.
- 180 students participated in Shauryaveer Run organised by MLIRC where one girl of class X won a bronze medal.
- The existing playground has been levelled, and plans are underway to develop a **new football ground and a basketball court** within available resources.

Teacher Empowerment

Our faculty is our greatest strength.

- Regular **teacher training programmes** were conducted on ICT integration, assessment reforms, NEP-aligned pedagogy, and classroom management.
- Teachers attended **CBSE and AWES capacity-building workshops**, ensuring the adoption of best practices.

- Continuous professional development has enabled teachers to act as mentors, counsellors, and innovators in classrooms.

Infrastructure Development

To support our growing needs and modern learning practices, substantial infrastructural enhancements were undertaken:

- **Construction of five new classrooms** and creation of a **dedicated IT Lab**
- **Installation of 25 Smart Interactive Panels**, with 25 more under process through HDFC Bank sponsorship
- **Upgradation of sanitary facilities** for boys and girls
- **Establishment of a Play Station for pre-primary learners**
- **Internal and external painting** of the triple-storey building
- **Procurement of new furniture**, classroom desks, plastic chairs, and portable stage setup

All these initiatives were completed with careful budgeting and resource optimization, reflecting our commitment to a safe and stimulating learning environment.

The Way Forward

With the support of our management and community, we aim to:

- **Extend the school to Classes XI and XII** in the upcoming **KLP Building**
- **Establishment of a Play Station for pre-primary learners**
- Upcoming IT lab with 40 computers and a projector
- Strengthen **digital integration** across classrooms
- Expand **career guidance, remedial, and counselling programs**
- Continue **teacher training** and **student leadership initiatives** through NCC and Clubs
